

English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic/ spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

In our genre work, we will be writing persuasive letters to Mrs Courtier, Acrostic poems and riddles and we will be writing about life in Year two and what we are looking forward to next year.

Art/ DT

In art this term we will be creating our own maps. We will be exploring pattern and texture, learning how to stain paper to create some very old looking maps. We will also be using beaten flowers from the forest to create some beautiful patterned bunting.

Maths

In maths this term we will be consolidating all concepts taught this year and deepening our understanding. We will be applying all of our skills and mathematical knowledge to solve problems. To do this, we will learn various problem solving strategies and build our resilience.

All of this will be taught in conjunction with learning vital number facts including counting in 3s and the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
