

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Self confidence & self awareness, managing feelings and behaviour, making relationships

This term, we will be looking at a range of different emotions and will be talking about times and situations when we may have felt a particular way. We will also be celebrating our differences and talking about some of the things we think we are good at.

Communication and Language

Listening & attention, understanding, Speaking

This term, we will be practising our listening skills by listening to one another tell stories, jokes or sing songs. We will also be joining in with role play and acting out our stories with one another and with adults in the class.

Physical Development

Moving & handling, health & self-care

We will continue to improve fundamental PE skills and moves by following the PE FUNS programme, as well as further developing our safe use of tools both in the forest and in our workshop area. We will also be looking at how diet and exercise can help us to stay healthy.

Literacy

Reading, Writing

We will be continuing to practise phonics daily, reading and writing words and simple sentences as well as learning new sounds. We will be making warning signs and wanted posters for the Big Bad Wolf, in addition to exploring some of the possible scenarios that might occur if the wolf were to suddenly turn up in other traditional tales!

Understanding the World

People & communities, the world, Technology

This term, we will be looking at some of the similarities and differences between our families and in our personal likes and dislikes. We will be using our time in the forest to look at how our immediate environment begins to change in spring and will also be looking for signs of life in the school pond. In addition, children will be looking at some familiar landmarks in the local area. We will be using ICT to take photos of one another, using letter formation and fairytale apps on the iPads and having a go at recording some of our stories.

Mathematics

Numbers, shape, space & measures

In maths this term, we will continue to develop our fluency in counting forwards and backwards from different numbers. We will also carry on developing our understanding of addition and subtraction, as well as practising using money to pay for snacks and using our measuring skills in cooking. At the end of term, we are inviting families to join us for an Easter egg maths trail.

Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring & using media & materials, being Imaginative

This term, we will be supporting children in developing their imaginary play—helping to create props for role play or imaginary worlds for small world play. We will be playing alongside the children to help them develop narrative in their play and in representing their own ideas, thoughts and feelings.
