

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Self confidence & self awareness, managing feelings and behaviour, making relationships

This term, we will be talking about how we, and others, show different feelings and emotions and how different feelings might affect our behaviour. We will also be talking about how we feel about moving classes—the things we are looking forward to as well as what we can do about the things that are worrying us.

## Communication and Language

Listening & attention, understanding, speaking

This term, we will be practising our listening and attention skills by following multi-step instructions. We will be using books, film clips and topic work to develop understanding and speaking skills, where there will be opportunities to express individual views and develop our own narratives and explanations.

## Physical Development

Moving & handling, health & self-care

In P.E. we will be working on a range of different skills related to track and field events, such as throwing, jumping and running. Regular hand-writing practice and fine motor activities will support development of fine motor skills and we will be continuing to talk about different ways in which we can ensure we stay healthy and safe.

## Literacy

Reading, writing

In phonics this term, we will be continuing to practice recognising and applying the sounds we have been taught this year, as well as working on reading and writing an increasing number of non-decodable words. We will continue to read regularly, showing our understanding by talking about what we have read, as well as writing questions, sentences and short narratives linked to our 'Wild World' topic.

These are some of the areas we will be covering with children through observation, play and small group work, as well as allowing children to follow and develop their own interests.

## Mathematics

Numbers, shape, space & measures

In maths, we will be consolidating the work we have done this year, looking at place value and number recognition in larger numbers and practising counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10. We will also be looking at missing number problems and continuing to practise our estimating, sharing and doubling skills, along with further work on time.

## Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring & using media & materials, being imaginative

This term we will be using a range of different materials and techniques to produce collaborative artworks that will be used to decorate our new outdoor canopy area. Children will be creating their own musical compositions inspired by some of the animals we have been finding out about during our topic work.

## Understanding the World

People & communities, the world, technology

To develop our understanding of the world around us, we will be looking at different uses of technology in the home and school environments as well as talking about some of the things that make us special or unique. We will be talking about different environments in the world along with wildlife which might be found there. We will find out about some of the adaptations to environment and the migrations which some animals undertake.

In Forest School we will be using skillets or griddles to cook some exciting dishes as well as practising tool skills - using hammers, whittling and making elder bead bracelets.
