

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Self confidence & self awareness, managing feelings and behaviour, making relationships

To develop our PSED skills this term, we will be thinking and talking about some of the emotions we feel at different times and looking at how we and others might express those emotions. We will also be thinking about how we feel about change as we prepare for Year 1.

Literacy

Reading, Writing

We will be continuing to practise phonics daily, reading and writing words and simple sentences and ensuring that we are confident using all the sounds we have been taught this year. We will be making and labelling pirate maps, writing about what we would get up to if we were pirates, writing bossy rules for on-board the pirate ship, and replying to, as well as sending, messages in bottles. We might even devise some delicious recipes for our hungry pirate crew!

Mathematics

Numbers, shape, space & measures

In maths, we will be revisiting addition and subtraction and will be practising recording number sentences. Children will also be practising counting in twos, fives and tens and will be using these skills to count out pirate money. We will continue to develop our 2D and 3D shape mathematical language and will be investigating how many cups of water will sink a pirate ship.

Communication and Language

Listening & attention, understanding, Speaking

Our communication and language skills this term will focus on expressing ideas and opinions about characters and events in stories, as well as developing our speaking skills through recounting narratives and imagining different possibilities or scenarios in our story making.

These are some of the areas we will be covering with children through observation, play and small group work, allowing children to follow and develop their own interests.

Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring & using media & materials, being Imaginative

Children will be encouraged to continue to develop role play and tell stories to perform with their friends for the rest of the class. We will also be exploring painting seascapes and using a range of materials to create sea monsters and pirate ships, as well as making props, such as telescopes, for role play.

Physical Development

Moving & handling, health & self-care

This term, we will be thinking about making healthy choices in the things we eat and in the exercise we take.

In PE we will be practising ball skills needed for throwing, catching and fielding, as well as beginning to use racquets. We will also have the opportunity to work in a small group to invent our own games to teach to others in the class.

Understanding the World

People & communities, the world, Technology

This term, we are going to look at a range of environments in the world and compare them to one another—what animals might live there and how is the weather different to where we live? We will be looking at what life was like on-board ships in the past to decide if we would like to be part of a pirate band.

We will be using iPads to take photos of ourselves dressed up and acting out pirate stories.
