

## English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic/ spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

During our genre work we will be exploring fictional stories with familiar settings, writing lists, looking at patterns and repetitive poems and rhyming poems.

## Art/DT

In art this term we will be drawing family portraits and making clay self-portrait tiles, using and applying various design techniques.

## PE

PE will be multi skills/fundamental movements and ball handling skills.

We will also have 2 hours of Forest School each week.

## Maths

In maths this term we will be focusing on place value of numbers up to 20, addition and subtraction.

We will be continuing our focus through a concrete, pictorial, abstract approach.

We will also learn problem solving strategies where we will have an opportunity to use and apply our mathematical knowledge.

All of this will be taught in conjunction with learning vital number facts including counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10 and learning number bonds to 10 and then 20 .

## PSHE

This term we will be thinking about what makes us special. We will think about our own families and the families of others. Whilst thinking about our own lives and daily activities we will consider those from other countries and cultures.

We will spend time thinking about building a safe and caring classroom. We will continue developing how to work together, learning to cooperate and work as a group. We will think about positive learning behaviours and developing confidence and responsibility.

## RE
