

English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic/ spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

During our genre work we will be exploring fictional stories with familiar settings, writing lists, looking at patterns and repetitive poems and rhyming poems.

Geography

In Geography this term we will be developing our knowledge about the world, the UK and our locality. We will name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.

Science

In science this term we will focus on animals, including humans. We will name body parts and senses and compare with those of common animals. We will collect data about differences between children. Also discuss the basic needs of pets and how to care for them.

Music

In Music this term, we will think about our favourite music and share this appreciation with the rest of the class.

Art/DT

In art this term we will be drawing self-portraits in the style of Vincent Van Gogh and Picasso. We will look at the differences and similarities between their styles. The children will develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

PE

In PE this term we will be following a 'real PE' approach developing fundamental movements. A specialist coach will also teach one afternoon a week.

Computing

In computing this term we will create, organise, store and retrieve data in the form of digital images, and will manipulate and combine them to create a collage about ourselves. We will be thinking and documenting what makes us an individual.

Maths

In maths this term we will be focusing on place value of numbers up to 20, addition and subtraction. We will be continuing our focus through a concrete, pictorial, abstract approach. We will also learn problem solving strategies where we will have an opportunity to use and apply our mathematical knowledge. All of this will be taught in conjunction with learning vital number facts including counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10 and learning number bonds to 10 and then 20.

RE

In RE this term we will draw on our understanding of belonging, and then relate it to how we may be given a sense of belonging in a particular religion. We will think about how people show they belong and what is special about belonging.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will think about what we want in our class and how we can build a caring classroom. We will continue developing how to work together, learning to cooperate and work as a group. We will also begin to recognise what we like and dislike, developing confidence to share our opinions and explore what is 'right' and 'wrong' and how we might decide this.
