

## English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic/ spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

During our genre work, we will be writing poems based on fun inventions and strange machines, creating reports on different types of animals and writing diary entries and stories based on fantastic voyages. As it is book week during this term, we will also be writing book reviews and participating in fun book-based activities.

## Art/DT

In art and DT this term, we will be continuing to design and make our own Excalibur swords and coat of arms. We will also be building bridges and testing the durability of different materials.

We will also be creating book jackets and book marks during our book week. In the lead up to Easter, we will partake in various crafts.

## Maths

In maths this term we will be learning money; understanding the different amounts as well as adding and subtracting it. We will continue number and place value work – securing our knowledge of 2 digit numbers. We will also be beginning to learn to tell the time, identify different fraction amounts and begin to measure volume and weight. We will also continue learning problem solving strategies where we will have an opportunity to use and apply our mathematical knowledge.

These will be taught in conjunction with learning vital number facts including counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and learning number bonds to 10 and 20.
