

## English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

During our genre work we will be discussing books and writing book reviews. We will also be focusing on Traditional Tales and writing alternative endings to them, as well as other tales-based activities.

## Art/ DT

In art this term we will be experimenting with different equipment and paint to create fairy-tale scenes including huff and puff pictures.

In DT we will be creating traditional tale story boxes. Also we will be cooking and looking at reversible and irreversible changes when making gingerbread men and healthy eating when making porridge.

## Maths

In maths this term we will revisit and extend our learning of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also find out how to measure height and length in various contexts, using standard and non-standard units of measure. As well as this we will also be learning about fractions of objects and amounts. We will continue learning maths through a concrete, pictorial, abstract approach.

We will also learn problem solving strategies where we will have an opportunity to use and apply our mathematical knowledge.

As well as this we will also have a weekly Mental Maths tests; continue counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and working on number bonds and their commutative and inverse related facts.

## PE

Our SEAL theme this term is: It's good to be me. We will also be thinking about citizenship and what makes us a good citizen. We will also link PSHE themes to traditional tales for example; stranger danger and Hansel and Gretel

## Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about internet safety and helping to create an informative display.

## Geography

This term we are going to create story sticks while mapping out the forest area and retelling traditional tales. We will create aerial maps for the forest and Orchard using a simple key. Also we will plan and map for the Jolly Postman to help him deliver post from the Post box to school.
