

English

In English, we have a 30 minutes phonic/ spelling session daily where we will consolidate and further our phonic understanding and learn new spelling rules and patterns. What is learnt during these sessions will feed into our daily English lessons.

We will also have a specific spelling, punctuation and grammar lesson once a week which will then be embedded in future English sessions.

During English lessons this term we will be creating instructions based on making fairy doors. As well as information and explanation pieces of text based on nocturnal animals.

As a class we will also be sharing stories by the same author- this term it will be Antony Browne.

Art/ DT

In art this term we will be experimenting with pattern, texture and collage when creating our own fairy tale gardens. As well as that we will also be designing and creating fairy door for trees in the forest.

Maths

In maths this term we will revisit and extend our learning of multiplication and division. As well as this we will also be putting addition and subtraction in to different perspectives.

We will continue learning maths through a concrete, pictorial, abstract approach.

We will also learn problem solving strategies where we will have an opportunity to use and apply our mathematical knowledge.

All of this will be taught in conjunction with learning vital number facts including counting in steps of 2,5 and 10; learning number bonds to 10 and 20.

PE
